PEER-TO-PEER SUPPORT

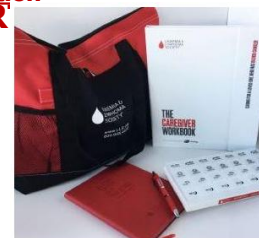
